NOTIFICATION OF MAINTENANCE WORKS A46 Ratcliffe on the Wreake Southbound Carriageway

I'm writing to let you know that we'll be closing the southbound exit slip road of the A46 Ratcliffe on the Wreake junction in December so that we can carry out work to clear vegetation. This will include trimming and removing some of the trees on the embankment, as well as planting new trees and shrubs.

The work is being carried out in preparation for a future scheme that will reinforce the embankment and carry out repairs to the drains and barriers. This scheme is planned to be carried out in mid-2022.

When will the work take place?

To keep disruption to a minimum, we'll be working over a weekend. Our work is due to start at **8pm on Friday 10 December 2021** and is estimated to be completed by **6am on Monday 13 December 2021**. Any noisy works will be carried out during the daytime, and temporary traffic management will be in place **24 hours a day**.

Please note that all our planned roadworks may be subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

How will the work affect traffic?

To maintain a safe environment for our workforce and all road users, we need to close the southbound exit slip road and one lane of the A46 southbound carriageway. The second southbound lane will still be running. During these closures, we will put in place a fully signed diversion route, which has been agreed with the Local Authority.

A drawing showing the diversion route has been included with this letter.
