### FUNDING

Over the last 12 months the Village Hall has been successful in obtaining funding from Charnwood Borough Members Grant and National Lottery Awards for All, totalling £3000 for a PA System and Hearing Loop, which was installed in April 2023.

# BUILDING MAINTENANCE WORKS

This year the internal hall doors have been upgraded to a new oak finish. The hall has also been freshly painted.

Our records show that during 2022, a total of £7096.89 was invested in the building maintenance of the hall, with a lot of routine electrical work taking place.

Thanks go to the volunteers who gave their time in helping with these refurbishments, and to our wonderful cleaners, Diane and Margaret, for keeping the hall in such a fantastic condition.

During the summer of 2023 we plan to replace the hall floor with a new Forbo Modul'up flooring.
